

HOUSE No. 440

Bill accompanying the petition of Henry F. Arnold for the establishment and maintenance of a market gardening station; Agriculture. Jan. 11.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To provide for a Market Garden Station under the Control of the Trustees of the Massachusetts Agricultural College.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be established a market garden
2 station for the purpose of carrying on experimental and
3 other work for the improvement of the market gardening
4 business. It shall be known as the Massachusetts
5 Market Garden Station. The management of the station
6 shall be under the control and direction of the trustees of
7 the Massachusetts agricultural college. Suitable land
8 for the above purpose shall be selected and purchased on
9 behalf of the commonwealth and proper buildings shall be
10 erected thereon by said trustees. The trustees are hereby

11 authorized to employ a superintendent and such other
12 assistants as may be necessary and to do all other things
13 proper for carrying out the purposes of this act.

1 SECTION 2. In procuring and preparing the said land,
2 in constructing the buildings and in equipping the station,
3 the said trustees may expend a sum not exceeding twenty
4 thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
