Bill accompanying the petition of Edward C. Stone that mutual liability companies be authorized to insure against liability for personal injury and property damage caused by teams and other vehicles, steam boilers and fly wheels. Insurance. January 11.

AN ACT

Relative to Insurance against Liability for Personal Injury and Property Damage caused by Teams, Steam-boilers or Fly-wheels.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The last paragraph of section thirty-four
2 of chapter five hundred and seventy-six of the acts and
3 resolves of the year nineteen hundred and seven, as
4 amended by chapter eighty-one of the acts and resolves
5 of nineteen hundred and eight, is hereby further amended
6 so as to read as follows:

7 "Mutual companies organized prior to the twenty-
8 eighth day of May in the year eighteen hundred and
9 ninety-six to transact employers' liability business may

10 continue such business under the fourth, fifth and eighth
11 clauses of section thirty-two as the same may have been
12 amended and shall be subject to the laws so far as appli-
13 cable relative to mutual fire insurance companies, so that
14 on and after the passage of this act such mutual com-
15 panies may transact all such business as may be author-
16 ized by the fourth, fifth and eighth clauses as the same
17 may have been amended of said section thirty-two."

1 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
