## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

### AN ACT

To provide for the Care of Government Property in the South Armory in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Three sergeants of the quartermaster  
2 corps of whom at least one shall be a skilled mechanic  
3 and one a skilled electrician, shall be permanently de-  
4 tailed to the coast artillery corps for duty in connection  
5 with the proper care and maintenance of government  
6 property contained in the south armory, Boston.

1 SECTION 2. Said sergeants shall each receive the pay  
2 of a post quartermaster sergeant whenever performing  
3 duties with the coast artillery corps prescribed by sec-  
4 tions one hundred and forty-one, one hundred and forty-  
5 two, one hundred and fifty-one, one hundred and fifty-

6 two and one hundred and sixty of the militia law and  
7 for all other duty performed hereunder shall receive  
8 special duty pay at two dollars per day for such number  
9 of days as may be approved by the adjutant general,  
10 upon recommendation and certificate of the chief of  
11 coast artillery. Such special duty pay, however, shall  
12 not exceed in the aggregate for said three sergeants in  
13 any one calendar year an amount in excess of fifteen  
14 hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
