## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation to cover Subsidies to Cities and Towns for Establishing and Maintaining Tuberculosis Hospitals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hundred  
2 and sixty-five thousand six hundred and fifty-one  
3 dollars and fifty cents is hereby appropriated, to  
4 be paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth,  
5 from the ordinary revenue, to certain cities and  
6 towns for amounts to which they are entitled for  
7 establishing and maintaining tuberculosis hos-  
8 pitals during the period ending November thirti-  
9 eth, nineteen hundred and fifteen. (Acts 1911,  
10 ch. 597; 1912, ch. 637.)

(Appropriation 1915, \$129,868.44.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
