## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for the Board of Registration in Medicine.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the salaries and expenses of the board of regis-  
5 tration in medicine, for the fiscal year ending on  
6 the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred  
7 and sixteen, to wit: —

8 For the salaries of the members of the board,  
9 forty-three hundred dollars. (Acts 1902, ch.  
10 505.)

(Appropriation 1915, \$4,300.)

11 For traveling and other expenses of the board,  
12 a sum not exceeding five hundred and seventy-  
13 five dollars. (Acts 1912, ch. 505.)

(Appropriation 1915, \$475.)

14 For clerical services, the sum of one thousand  
15 dollars. (Acts 1902, ch. 505; 1914, ch. 605.)

(Appropriation 1915, \$1,000.)

16 For printing, postage, office supplies and con-  
17 tingent expenses of the members of the board, to  
18 include printing the annual report, and for rent  
19 of rooms outside the state house, a sum not ex-  
20 ceeding sixteen hundred and twenty-five dollars.  
21 (Acts 1902, ch. 505.)

(Appropriation 1915, \$1,710.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
