Bill accompanying the petition of John F. Keyes relative to the placing of suitable painters' hooks on wooden buildings. Mercantile Affairs. January 14.

AN ACT

Relative to the Placing of Painters' Hooks on Wooden Buildings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No wooden buildings of two stories or
2 over in height in any city shall hereafter be constructed
3 without having placed thereon suitable painters' hooks
4 subject to the approval of the building inspector.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
