Bill accompanying the petition of the Massachusetts State Automobile Association for the dimming of headlights on cars of street railway companies when approaching vehicles on the highway. Roads and Bridges. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

AN ACT

Relative to dimming of Headlights by Public Service Corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All public service corporations operating
2 street cars on or near the public streets or highways of
3 this commonwealth shall cause all dazzling headlights
4 upon such street cars to be put out or dimmed upon the
5 approach of any vehicle upon said public streets or high-
6 ways when the driver of said vehicle is likely to be
7 dazzled thereby.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
