

HOUSE No. 919

Bill accompanying the petition of Arthur W. Sim and others for the establishment of a police court in the town of Peabody. Joint Judiciary. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To establish a Police Court in the Town of Peabody.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Peabody shall constitute a
2 judicial district under the jurisdiction of a court to be
3 called the police court of Peabody. All the provisions
4 of law applicable to police courts shall apply to said
5 court.

1 SECTION 2. There shall be one justice and two special
2 justices and a clerk of the court.

1 SECTION 3. Sittings of the said court shall be held at
2 Peabody daily, except on Sundays and legal holidays.
3 Sittings of the court for civil business shall be held each
4 week at Peabody and as required by law, and on such
5 other days as may be fixed by rule of court.

1 SECTION 4. The first session of said court shall be
2 held on the first day of June in the year nineteen hundred
3 and sixteen.

1 SECTION 5. So much of this act as relates to the
2 appointing and qualifying of the justices of the court
3 and the clerk of the court shall take effect upon its
4 passage, and the remainder shall take effect on the first
5 day of June in the year nineteen hundred and sixteen.
