AN ACT

Relative to Employees in Places where Intoxicating Liquors
are Sold.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 It shall be unlawful to employ in any saloon or other
- 2 place in which intoxicating liquors are sold any person
- 3 who has not been for the preceding two years a legal
- 4 voter in the city or town in which the saloon or other
- 5 place is situated.
