Bill accompanying the petition of James E. Phelan that the city of Boston be authorized to pay a pension to the widow of Arthur F. Mendell. Cities. January 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to pay a Pension to the
Widow of Arthur F. Mendell.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized
2 to pay to the widow of Arthur F. Mendell an annual pen-
3 sion of not less than three hundred dollars so long as she
4 lives and remains unmarried, the said Arthur F. Mendell
5 having formerly been a member of the fire department of
6 the city of Boston and his death having occurred in con-
7 sequence of an injury received by him in the course of
8 his employment as a fireman.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by the city council with the approval of the
3 mayor of the city of Boston.
