

Bill accompanying the petition of John R. Fairbain that the office and salary of the chief deputy sheriff for attendance on the Superior Court for the county of Middlesex be established. Public Service. January 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To establish the Office and Salary of Chief Deputy Sheriff for Attendance upon the Superior Court for the County of Middlesex.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sheriff of the county of Middlesex
2 may appoint one of the court officers of the superior
3 court as chief deputy sheriff for attendance on the
4 superior court of said county. Such officer, under the
5 orders of the sheriff, and in addition to his regular
6 duties as a court officer, shall supervise, direct and assign
7 the officers of the said court. The said chief deputy
8 sheriff shall hold his office subject to the provisions of
9 chapter one hundred and thirty-four of the acts of the
10 year nineteen hundred and twelve. He shall be paid by
11 the county in equal monthly instalments the sum of
12 twenty-one hundred dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
