

HOUSE No. 1126

Bill accompanying the petition of Charles P. Maxfield and others that a certain part of Washington street in the town of Fairhaven be maintained as a state highway. Roads and Bridges. January 18.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Maintenance of a Part of Washington Street in the Town of Fairhaven as a State Highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That part of Washington street, in the
2 town of Fairhaven, extending westerly from the westerly
3 end of the present state highway to the intersection of
4 said Washington street with a road known as Alden
5 road shall be taken charge of by the commonwealth and
6 maintained as a state highway.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
