

HOUSE No. 1322

Bill accompanying the petition of the mayor of the city of Cambridge that said city be authorized to retire and pension John F. Reilly. Cities. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Cambridge to grant a Pension to John F. Reilly.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Cambridge,
2 with the approval of the mayor, is hereby authorized to
3 retire John F. Reilly, employed as a sub-foreman in the
4 street department, at his request, and if so retired he
5 shall receive from the city of Cambridge for the remainder
6 of his life an annual pension equal to one half of the
7 average compensation paid to him during the two years
8 next prior to his retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act is to take effect upon its passage.
