

HOUSE No. 1352

Bill accompanying the petition of John J. Cummings relative to the sale of personal property taken on execution. Joint Judiciary. January 20.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Personal Property taken on Execution.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The officer shall give notice of the time
2 and place of the sale, by causing notices thereof to be
3 posted forty-eight hours at least before the time of the
4 sale in a public place in the city or town in which the
5 sale is to be made, or by causing an advertisement of the
6 time and place of sale to be published in a newspaper
7 published in the county.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter one hundred and thirty-one of
2 the general acts of the year nineteen hundred and fifteen
3 is hereby repealed.
