AN ACT

To authorize the City of Lynn to appropriate Money for the
Lynn Hospital.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Lynn is hereby authorized to
2 raise annually, by taxation, a sum of money not exceed-
3 ing ten thousand dollars, and to appropriate the same
4 toward the maintenance of the Lynn hospital.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters
2 of the city of Lynn at the city election in the current
3 year, and shall take effect upon its acceptance by a
4 majority of the voters voting thereon.
