

HOUSE No. 1539

Bill accompanying the petition of William H. Sayward relative to the handling of explosives. Mercantile Affairs. January 21.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

To regulate the Transportation and Use of Dynamite and Other Similar Explosives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No person shall transport or use dynamite
2 or other similar explosives unless licensed by the chief of
3 the district police. A fee of one dollar may be charged
4 for such license.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect sixty days after
2 its passage.
