AN ACT

Relative to Ice Wagons and Motor Trucks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Any ice wagon or motor truck used in the transporta-
- 2 tion of goods or merchandise shall have an unobstructed
- 3 view of the rear wheels by the driver. No hood or cover-
- 4 ing shall be used upon said trucks or motor vehicles that
- 5 will, in any way, interfere with said obstructed view.
- 6 Any truck over four ton traveling through the congested
- 7 streets of any city shall have two men, one man in the
- 8 rear to guide it.
