AN ACT

Relative to the Membership of the Salem and Beverly
Water Supply Board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter seven hundred of
2 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, as
3 amended by chapter six hundred and thirty-two of the
4 acts of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen, is
5 hereby further amended by striking out in the second
6 sentence thereof the words "the director of the division
7 of public works", and inserting in place thereof the
8 words:—the city engineer; and by striking out in the
9 same sentence the words "or in case there is no commis-
10 sioner, the deputy commissioner of public works",—
11 so that said sentence will read as follows:—The city
12 engineer of the city of Salem and the commissioner of
13 public works of the city of Beverly shall be members of
14 said board, ex officiiis.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
