## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of  
the Lyman School for Boys.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding one hun-  
2 dred twenty-three thousand eight hundred and  
3 fifty dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid  
4 out of the treasury of the commonwealth, from  
5 the ordinary revenue, for the maintenance of the  
6 Lyman school for boys during the fiscal year  
7 ending on the thirtieth day of November, nine-  
8 teen hundred and sixteen. (Rev. Laws, ch. 86.)

(Appropriation 1915, \$123,500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
