

HOUSE No. 1863

Bill accompanying the petition of William E. Blodgett that the Boston Sunday Evangelistic Committee, Incorporated, be authorized to construct and use a building in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs. March 13.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Construction and Use of a Building by the Boston Sunday Evangelistic Committee, Incorporated.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Boston Sunday Evangelistic Com-
2 mittee, Incorporated, an association duly incorporated
3 under the laws of this commonwealth, is hereby author-
4 ized to construct and use for religious purposes a
5 building at number three hundred and fifty Hunt-
6 ington avenue in the city of Boston between Gains-
7 boro street and Bryant street, with a hall or
8 assembly room to contain an audience of not less than
9 ten thousand persons. The said building shall conform
10 in respect to entrances, exits, passageways and seating,
11 with the provisions of existing law; but shall in other

12 respects be of third class construction and may be built
13 upon temporary foundations satisfactory to the building
14 commissioner of the city of Boston: and *provided, also,*
15 that the said corporation shall give to the building
16 commissioner a bond of some reputable surety company
17 in the sum of five thousand dollars, conditioned upon
18 the taking down and removal of said building, without
19 expense to the city of Boston, not later than eight
20 months after the completion of the said building.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
