AN ACT

To provide for the Payment of a Certain Sum of Money by
the City of Fitchburg to the Town of Ashby.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Fitchburg shall, within six
2 months after the passage of this act, pay to the town of
3 Ashby the sum of seven thousand dollars in full compen-
4 sation for the loss sustained by said town by the taking
5 of certain taxable property other than land therein under
6 the provisions of chapter two hundred and ninety-seven
7 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not affect the amount which
2 may be paid by the city of Fitchburg to the town of
3 Ashby in lieu of taxes upon the land, under the provisions
4 of Revised Laws, chapter twelve, section ten, and amend-
5 ments thereto.
