RESOLVE

To authorize the Town of Framingham to construct and maintain a Drain through the State Camp Ground.

1 *Resolved*, That the governor, with the advice and con-
2 sent of the council, is hereby authorized to grant permis-
3 sion to the town of Framingham, upon such terms and
4 conditions as he may fix, to construct and maintain a
5 drain for surface water in and through the state camp
6 ground in said town.
