RESOLVE

Providing for Certain Improvements at the Westborough
State Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
3 the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, to be expended under
4 the direction of the state board of insanity for the purpose
5 of remodeling, renovating and refurnishing female wards
6 numbers one, two, four and five.
