AN ACT

To authorize the American Woolen Company of Massachusetts to engage in the Business of an Electric Company in the Towns of Acton and Maynard.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The American Woolen Company of Mas-
2 sachussets, in addition to its other corporate powers, is
3 hereby authorized to carry on the business of an electric
4 company in the towns of Acton and Maynard, and in
5 respect to said business shall have all the powers and
6 privileges and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and
7 restrictions of an electric company under all general laws
8 now or hereafter in force in relation thereto, so far as the
9 same may be applicable; and for said purpose said com-
10 pany may acquire and enjoy all the property and loca-
11 tions of the American Woolen Company of New Jersey
14 in said towns now owned and used by the latter com-
13 pany in the distribution and sale of electricity to said
14 towns and their respective inhabitants; and upon the
15 acquisition of said property and locations by said Ameri-
16 can Woolen Company of Massachusetts all the rights

17 of the American Woolen Company of New Jersey under
18 the provisions of chapter three hundred and forty-seven
19 of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and two and
20 chapters four hundred and five and five hundred and
21 ^athirty-five of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
22 ^bsix shall cease.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
