RESOLVE

In Favor of Emma E. De Shazo.

1 *Resolved*, That Emma E. De Shazo of Worcester be
2 allowed and paid from the treasury of the commonwealth
3 during her lifetime in full compensation for the death of
4 her husband, James B. De Shazo, who died as a result of
5 injuries received by him on November thirteen, nineteen
6 hundred and fourteen, while in the discharge of his duties
7 as a member of the boiler inspection department of the
8 district police of the commonwealth of Massachusetts,
9 compensation at the rate of five hundred dollars per
10 annum, payable quarterly: *provided, however*, that when
11 the payments hereunder shall amount to three thousand
12 dollars said compensation shall cease.
