

SENATE No. 83

To accompany the petition of Henry L. Hansen that the salaries of certain members and clerks of the boiler inspection department of the district police be established. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To regulate the Salaries of Certain Members and Clerks in the Boiler Inspection Department of the District Police.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The annual salary of the members
2 of the boiler inspection department of the district
3 police, whose maximum salary is now from fifteen
4 hundred dollars to seventeen hundred and fifty
5 dollars per year, shall hereafter be as follows:—
6 Sixteen hundred dollars for the first year of serv-
7 ice, seventeen hundred dollars for the second year
8 of service, eighteen hundred dollars for the third
9 year of service, nineteen hundred dollars for the
10 fourth year, two thousand for the fifth year and
11 thereafter twenty-one hundred dollars per year.

12 The annual salary of the two stenographers in the
13 boiler inspection department of the district police
14 whose salaries are now one thousand dollars and
15 twelve hundred dollars, respectively, shall here-
16 after be as follows:— One thousand dollars and
17 twelve hundred dollars respectively for the first
18 year of service, eleven hundred dollars and
19 thirteen hundred dollars for the second year,
20 twelve hundred dollars and fourteen hundred
21 dollars for the third year and thereafter thirteen
22 hundred dollars and fifteen hundred dollars
23 respectively per year.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts incon-
2 sistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
