

SENATE No. 152

To accompany the petition of Arthur W. Colburn that the standards for total milk solids and milk fats be harmonized. Agriculture and Public Health, sitting jointly.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventeen.

AN ACT

To harmonize the Standards for Total Milk Solids and Milk Fat.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section fifty-six of chapter fifty-six of the Re-
2 vised Laws, as amended by chapter six hundred
3 and forty-three of the acts of the year nineteen
4 hundred and eight, is hereby further amended by
5 striking out the words "and fifteen hundredths",
6 in the fourth line, so as to read as follows:— *Sec-*
7 *tion 56.* In prosecutions under the provisions of
8 sections fifty-one to sixty-four, inclusive, milk
9 which, upon analysis, is shown to contain less
10 than twelve per cent of milk solids or less than
11 three and thirty five hundredths per cent of fat,
12 shall not be considered of good standard quality.
