AN ACT

To provide for the Reinstatement of Dominick Hawkins in the Public Works Department of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of public works
2 in the city of Boston, with the approval of the
3 mayor, is hereby authorized to reinstate Dominick
4 Hawkins in said public works department, with-
5 out examination, at any time prior to the thirty-
6 first day of December in the current year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
