RESOLVE

Providing for Additions and Repairs at the Hatcheries under the Control of the Board of Commissioners on Fisheries and Game.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding seven-
3 teen thousand and thirty-five dollars, to be expended
4 under the direction of the board of commissioners on
5 fisheries and game, for the following purposes:— at the
6 Martha's Vineyard reservation for addition to superin-
7 tendent's house, one thousand dollars; at the Palmer
8 hatchery for construction of ponds, rearing pools, barn,
9 and additions and repairs to superintendent's house, six
10 thousand three hundred and fifty dollars; at the Sand-
11 wich fish hatcheries for construction of cement ponds,
12 cement nursery ponds, including supply and overflow
13 trough at the East Sandwich branch, three thousand
14 eight hundred dollars; at the Sutton hatchery for in-
15 stallation of water supply, rebuilding trout pens, and
16 constructing pools, one thousand six hundred and eighty-
17 five dollars; at Wilbraham game farm for automobile and
18 construction of barn, four thousand two hundred dollars.
