To accompany the petition of the selectmen of the town of Palmer, by Harold W. Brainerd, chairman, that said town be authorized to appropriate money toward the cost of constructing a certain bridge across the Ware River in said town. Towns.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Palmer to appropriate Money toward the Cost of a Bridge to be constructed by the Springfield Street Railway Company for its Exclusive Use across the Ware River in Said Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Palmer is hereby au-
2 thorized to raise and appropriate a sum not ex-
3 ceeding one thousand dollars and pay the same
4 to the Springfield Street Railway Company as a
5 contribution toward the cost of a bridge to be
6 constructed by said railway company for its
7 exclusive use across the Ware river in said town
8 near the Dutton bridge, so-called.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
