

Resolve accompanying the recommendations of the Director of the Massachusetts Bureau of Prisons (House, No. 80). Public Institutions. January 4.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation by the Director of the Massachusetts Bureau of Prisons as to a New Site for the State Prison.

1 *Resolved*, That the director of the Massachusetts
2 bureau of prisons shall investigate and determine upon
3 a favorable location for the building of a suitable prison
4 for the safe confinement of such prisoners as by law are
5 or may be confined in the state prison; and he shall in-
6 vestigate and determine as to what the general form of
7 construction and arrangement of buildings shall be.

8 In effecting the purpose of this resolve the said director
9 is hereby authorized to visit institutions for the in-
10 carceration of felons in other states and he may delegate
11 any member or members of the bureau of prisons to visit
12 said institutions.

13 The director shall report to the general court on or
14 before the first Monday in January, nineteen hundred and
15 nineteen, with such recommendations for legislation, if
16 any, as may be deemed necessary.

17 There may be expended by the director, with the ap-
18 proval of the governor and council, a sum not exceeding
19 five thousand dollars for the purpose of this resolve, which
20 sum is hereby appropriated.
