

HOUSE No. 145

Bill accompanying the petition of John Mitchell that persons in the military and naval service of the United States be exempted from the payment of poll taxes. Taxation. January 4.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

AN ACT

To exempt Persons in the Military or Naval Service of the United States from the Payment of Poll Taxes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Citizens of Massachusetts who are engaged
2 in the military or naval service of the United States shall
3 be exempt from the payment of a poll tax during the
4 continuance of the present war.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
