

Bill accompanying the petition of the Association of Massachusetts Sanitary Inspectors that building commissioners, building inspectors and other like officers be placed under the civil service laws and rules. Public Service. January 15.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

AN ACT

To place Building Commissioners, Building Inspectors and Other Like Officers under Civil Service Rules.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter nineteen of the
2 Revised Laws entitled "Of the civil service", and all
3 acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto, and
4 the civil service rules made thereunder, shall hereafter
5 apply to the appointment of all building commissioners,
6 superintendents of public buildings and inspectors of
7 buildings employed in any city or town of the common-
8 wealth other than the city of Boston, and their term of
9 office, and the term of those now in office, shall be per-
10 manent, except that they may be removed in accordance
11 with existing laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
