

HOUSE No. 912

Bill accompanying the petition of George H. Jennings that the employment of women and minors between certain hours by street railway companies be prohibited. Social Welfare. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

AN ACT

Relative to the Labor of Women and Children employed by
Street Railway Companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. That no woman or minor under twenty-
2 one years of age shall be employed in any capacity
3 between the hours of six o'clock at night and seven
4 o'clock in the morning by any electric street railway
5 company operating within the confines of the state of
6 Massachusetts.

7 The above prohibition shall be held to apply to any
8 electric railway system operating cars or trains on the
9 public streets or by means of subways, tunnels or over-
10 head structures.

1 SECTION 2. This act to take effect upon its passage.
