

HOUSE No. 1001

Bill accompanying the petition of Alfred Ray Mitchell and others for the establishment of a junior police department in the city of Boston. Metropolitan Affairs. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

AN ACT

Establishing a Junior Police Department in Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A junior police department shall be estab-
2 lished in the city of Boston on the first day of May, nine-
3 teen hundred and eighteen. The mayor of Boston shall
4 have charge of appointments to this force. ,

1 SECTION 2. The patrolmen of this force shall be be-
2 tween the ages of fifteen and seventeen. No other
3 member shall be under the age of fifteen or over twenty-
4 one.

1 SECTION 3. The mayor shall regulate the salaries of
2 members of this force. The force is to have an annual
3 appropriation from the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 4. The chief shall submit an annual report to
2 the mayor of Boston.

1 SECTION 5. All acts inconsistent herewith are hereby
2 repealed.
