### RESOLVE

Granting Annuities to Sarah B. Pocknett and Rebecca C.  
Hammond of Mashpee.

1 *Resolved*, There shall be paid annually from the treasury  
2 of the commonwealth, in equal quarterly instalments,  
3 from the first day of December, nineteen hundred and  
4 seventeen, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars each  
5 to Sarah B. Pocknett and Rebecca C. Hammond, both of  
6 Mashpee and descendants of the Algonquin tribe of  
7 Indians.
