RESOLVE

In Favor of Charles F. Pidgin of Brookline.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the commonwealth annually for a period of
3 five years to Charles F. Pidgin of Brookline, provided
4 he so long survives, the sum of five hundred dollars, in
5 monthly instalments, in recognition of his faithful service
6 in the bureau of statistics of labor from the year eighteen
7 hundred and seventy-three to the year nineteen hundred
8 and seven.
