AN ACT

Relative to the Charter of the Shirley-Eustis House Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The purpose of the Shirley-Eustis House Association,
2 incorporated under chapter one hundred and twenty-
3 five of the Revised Laws on February twenty-eighth,
4 nineteen hundred and thirteen, shall be to purchase,
5 preserve and maintain as an educational, historic and
6 patriotic museum the Shirley-Eustis House, so-called,
7 situated in Boston.
