## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

### AN ACT

To authorize the City of Somerville to retire and pension Charles C. Folsom.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of aldermen of the city of  
2 Somerville, with the approval of the mayor, is hereby  
3 authorized to retire, at his request, Charles C. Folsom,  
4 employed continuously as general agent of the overseers  
5 of the poor for thirty-two years, and prior to that for  
6 eleven and one half years a patrolman and sergeant in  
7 the police department; and if so retired he shall receive  
8 from the city of Somerville for the remainder of his life  
9 an annual pension equal to one half of the compensation  
10 paid to him at the time of his retirement.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
