### RESOLVE

Providing for the Appointment of a Special Commission to revise and codify the Laws relating to Towns.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission of three persons be  
2 appointed by the governor, with the advice and consent  
3 of the council, to revise and codify the laws relating to  
4 towns, recommending such changes in substance and  
5 policy as may be deemed expedient. The commission  
6 shall report its recommendations, with bills embodying  
7 the same, to the present general court not later than the  
8 third Wednesday of April. The members shall receive  
9 no compensation, but may incur necessary expenses for  
10 clerical assistance not exceeding the sum of five hundred  
11 dollars.
