## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Construction of a New Bridge over the  
Monatiquot River in the Town of Braintree.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter three hundred and  
2 fifteen of the General Acts of nineteen hundred and  
3 seventeen is hereby amended by striking out the words  
4 “within eighteen months after the passage of this act”,  
5 in the second and third lines, and substituting the words:  
6 — not later than the first day of January, nineteen hun-  
7 dred and twenty, — and by striking out the word “ten”,  
8 in the tenth line, and substituting the word: — sixty, —  
9 so as to read as follows: — *Section 1.* The county com-  
10 missioners of Norfolk county are hereby directed, not  
11 later than the first day of January, nineteen hundred and  
12 twenty, subject to the provisions of chapter ninety-six of  
13 the Revised Laws, of the amendments thereof, and of all  
14 other general laws which may be applicable, to remove  
15 the existing bridge or bridges and to construct a new  
16 bridge with suitable approaches, substantially replacing  
17 the present bridge over Monatiquot river, so-called, on  
18 Quincy avenue in the town of Braintree, at an expense

19 not exceeding one hundred and sixty thousand dollars.  
20 The said bridge shall be constructed with a draw having  
21 an opening not less than fifty feet wide, and shall be of  
22 such width, grade, material and construction as said  
23 board of commissioners shall deem necessary or proper.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of carrying out the pro-  
2 visions of chapter three hundred and fifteen of the General  
3 Acts of nineteen hundred and seventeen, the county com-  
4 missioners of Norfolk county are hereby authorized to  
5 borrow and expend, subject to the provisions of said  
6 chapter except as otherwise provided herein, the addi-  
7 tional sum of fifty thousand dollars. But said addi-  
8 tional sum shall be assessed upon the county of Plymouth  
9 under the provisions of section six of said chapter three  
10 hundred and fifteen, to the extent only that the commis-  
11 sioners appointed under said section six determine that  
12 the said county is benefited by such additional expenditure.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
