AN ACT

Relative to the Amount of the Pension or Annuity Payable to Retired Municipal Employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The aggregate sum payable annually by way
2 of annuity or pension to a retired member of a
3 city or town retirement association, established
4 under the provisions of chapter six hundred and
5 nineteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and ten
6 and amendments thereof, shall not be less than
7 one half of the compensation to which he would
8 have been entitled for full employment during
9 the last year of his service.
