**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.**

**AN ACT**

Relative to Deposits of Money in the Courts of the  
County of Suffolk.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Money with all accumulated in-  
2 terest thereon which has been paid into the courts  
3 of the county of Suffolk and which has not been  
4 ordered paid to the party or parties litigant en-  
5 titled thereto, and money which may be here-  
6 after paid into the courts for the county of  
7 Suffolk, shall be turned over to the treasurer of  
8 the county of Suffolk and all interest on said  
9 money be used for general county business; and  
10 the principal shall be paid over by the county,  
11 through its treasury department, to the party  
12 entitled thereto on an order by the court in  
13 which said money was deposited.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
