AN ACT

Relative to the Operation of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section nine of chapter five hundred and thirty-
2 four of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 nine is hereby amended by striking out said sec-
4 tion and substituting the following: — *Section 9.*
5 No person shall operate any motor vehicle nor
6 shall any motor vehicle be operated upon any
7 way in this commonwealth unless such vehicle
8 is registered in accordance with the provisions of
9 this act, nor unless such vehicle is equipped as
10 provided in sections five, six and seven, except as
11 is otherwise provided in section three.
