AN ACT

Relative to the Election of Certain Trustees of Tufts
College.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subject to the provisions of section
2 one of chapter one hundred and forty-one of the
3 acts of eighteen hundred and fifty-two, as
4 amended by section one of chapter two hundred
5 and fifty-five of the acts of nineteen hundred and
6 seven, and of section two of said chapter two
7 hundred and fifty-five, the ten members of the
8 trustees of the Tufts College in Medford, incor-
9 porated by said chapter one hundred and forty-
10 one, who are elected by the alumni of said college,
11 shall be nominated and elected in accordance
12 with rules and regulations formulated by the
13 alumni association of Tufts College, acting
14 through its executive or other governing board
15 or committee, which shall become effective when
16 approved by the trustees of said college. Said
17 rules and regulations may be altered or amended

18 at any time in the same manner as originally
19 adopted, and shall take effect as altered or
20 amended when approved in like manner.

1 SECTION 2. Until said rules and regulations
2 are adopted as above provided, said ten members
3 shall be nominated and elected in accordance
4 with the provisions of section three of said chapter
5 two hundred and fifty-five.

1 SECTION 3. Except for the purposes set forth
2 in section two, said section three of said chapter
3 two hundred and fifty-five is hereby repealed.
