AN ACT

Relative to the Appointment of an Additional
Deputy in the Department of the Auditor of the
Commonwealth.

EMERGENCY PREAMBLE.

1 *Whereas*, An emergency exists requiring the
2 immediate passage and operation of the following
3 act which will enable the appointment of a dep-
4 uty in the department of the auditor, already
5 authorized by law, without the delays and re-
6 strictions imposed by the civil service laws,
7 accordingly the act is declared to be an emer-
8 gency act, as necessary to the preservation of
9 the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The appointment of the addi-
2 tional deputy in the department of the auditor,
3 authorized by section four of chapter two hun-
4 dred and forty-four of the General Acts of nine-
5 teen hundred and eighteen, shall be subject to
6 confirmation by the governor and council.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
