The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nineteen.

AN ACT

To provide for the Completion of the Wellesley Extension of the High-level Sewer authorized by Chapter Three Hundred and Forty-three of the Acts of the Year Nineteen Hundred and Fourteen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The treasurer and receiver general
2 of the commonwealth, in order to provide for the
3 completion of the extension of the high-level
4 sewer authorized by chapter three hundred and
5 forty-three of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
6 dred and fourteen, shall, with the approval of
7 the governor and council, issue from time to
8 time scrip or certificates of debt in the name and

9 behalf of the commonwealth and under its seal,
10 to an amount not exceeding two hundred and
11 twenty-five thousand dollars, in addition to the
12 amount authorized to be issued under the provi-
13 sions of said chapter and chapter two hundred
14 and eighty-five of the acts of the year nineteen
15 hundred and seventeen; the rate of interest to
16 be paid thereon to be such as the treasurer and
17 receiver general, with the approval of the governor
18 and council, may determine; and shall be for
19 such terms as the general court may subsequently
20 provide upon the recommendation of the
21 governor, in accordance with section three of
22 article LXII of the amendments to the consti-
23 tution; and the provisions of said chapter three
24 hundred and forty-three of the acts of the year
25 nineteen hundred and fourteen and of chapter
26 four hundred and twenty-four of the acts of the
27 year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine and of all
28 acts in amendment thereof and in addition thereto
29 shall, so far as applicable, apply to the indebted-
30 ness and proceedings authorized by this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
