**AN ACT**

Relative to Appropriations for School Purposes  
in the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The school committee of the city  
2 of Boston, in addition to the sums that it is now  
3 authorized by law to appropriate, in each year  
4 beginning with the year nineteen hundred and  
5 twenty, may appropriate such sum of money as  
6 may be necessary or requisite to provide and pay  
7 an annual increase of six hundred dollars to the

8 present salary of each of the teachers in the public  
9 schools in the city of Boston, and nothing con-  
10 tained in any statute, heretofore enacted or  
11 operative, shall prevent the said school committee  
12 from making such increase of such salaries im-  
13 mediately effective whenever the funds therefor  
14 shall be or become available under the provisions  
15 of this act, or under any other provisions of law.  
16 The additional appropriation herein authorized  
17 shall be a part of and shall be met by taxes within  
18 the tax limit.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act the  
2 limit of the amount of taxes on property in the  
3 city of Boston is extended and increased in the  
4 year nineteen hundred and twenty and in each  
5 year thereafter in such amount upon each one  
6 thousand dollars of the valuation upon which the  
7 appropriations of the city council of the city of  
8 Boston are based as may be required to provide  
9 for the appropriation by the school committee  
10 authorized by section one of this act.'

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on  
2 January first, nineteen hundred and twenty.
