AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DRIVERS OF BULK MILK TANK PICKUP TRUCKS TO BE PROPERLY QUALIFIED AND LICENSED TO TEST AND SAMPLE THE PRODUCT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 40, chapter 94, as most recently amended by chap-
2 ter 757 of the acts of 1955, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following section: —

4 *Section 40A.* No driver or other person employed in the
5 carrying of milk in bulk tank trucks shall pick up, deliver, ex-
6 change, expose for sale or have in his custody or possession with
7 intent so to do any milk, skim milk or cream unless licensed to
8 do so by the director who shall satisfy himself that said person
9 is properly qualified to test and sample the product.
