By Mr. Murray of Beverly, petition of Joseph Henry St. Laurent and others relative to providing that certain wartime service in the armed forces be considered as creditable service under the laws relating to retirement systems. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT PROVIDING WARTIME SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES AS CREDITABLE SERVICE UNDER ANY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE GENERAL LAWS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Any veteran, as defined in clause forty-three of section seven
2 of chapter four of the General Laws, eligible for retirement un-
3 der any provision of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws,
4 shall have credited to him as creditable service the period of his
5 wartime service.
